PROCLAMATION.

Subtle but well-directed propaganda is being carried on in our country to destroy our present form of government and create lawlessness, unrest, and distrust of our most cherished institutions. This propaganda threatens not only our Constitution, but our various religious organizations and even the home itself.


Our federal Constitution is probably the most wonderful document ever drawn by the hand of man, for insuring justice to all and guaranteeing to everyone life, liberty and the right to seek happiness in his own way. It affords opportunities to each individual to grow and develop, intellectually and materially. The future welfare of our nation demands that the basic principles of the Constitution be preserved. An orderly method has been provided for making changes in the Constitution when public sentiment, after due deliberation demands a change, but until changes are made, we should obey both its letter and its spirit.

NOW THEREFORE, I, J. A. O. Preus, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby set aside Sunday, January 22, as Law and Order Sunday, and urge its observance throughout the state. Efforts should be made, in churches and other public gatherings, to impress upon our people not only the privileges they enjoy under our Constitution, but also the duties and obligations it imposes upon them. They should understand that the laws made under the constitution are intended for the welfare of the whole public, and that it is for the mutual welfare of all that they be obeyed.
