- ORDINANCE NO. 623

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate limits of the City of Willmar, a Municipal Corporation, of the State of Minnesota, to Include Certain Lands not Exceeding 200 Acres.

Whereas, A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Willman, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Minnesota, by the property owner having the sole interest therein, to have certain real property hereinafter described included within the limits of the City of Willman, Minnesota, and

Whereas, It is proposed to annex by virtue hereof to gaid City of Willmar said property, all of which said property is in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, and

Whereas, The property to be annexed consists of 8,5 acres more or less, described as follows, to-wit:

The East 720 feet of the West 753 feet of the North 580 feet, except the South 165 feet of the East 320 feet thereof; all in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 12, Township 119 North, Range 35 West, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota.

Now Therefore, The City Council of the City of Willnar hereby determines, ordains and declares as follows:

Section 1. Best interests of the City of Willmar and area to be annexed. That the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and of the property affected.

Section 2. Abuts on City Limits. That the property above described abuts on the City Limits and is so conditioned as property to be subject to the City Government.

Section 3. Annexation. That the property is hereby annexed to, and included within, the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.

Section 4. Zoning. The area described shall be zoned B-2 Business District.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be filed and shall take effect and be of full force and effect from and after the filing of a copy of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Willmar Town Clerk, the Kandiyohi County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and from and after its passage and publication.
