AN ORDINANCE AMENDING INTERPRETED LAND ADJUDICATING
AND MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF SPRING GROVE

The City Council of the City of Spring Grove ordains:

Section 1. A petition having been filed with the City Council by
Gilman S. Lynch and Elvina Lynch, owners in fee of certain real estate located
in Spring Grove Township, Houston County, Minnesota, and described as follows,
to-wit:

A parcel of land located in the northwest one quarter of
the southwest one quarter of Section 12, Township 101
North Range 7 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian com-
mencing at the northwest corner of the southwest one
quarter; thence west on north line of said one quarter,
a distance of 400 feet to point of beginning; thence
west, a distance of 500 feet; thence south 50 feet;
thence west 320 feet to the west line of the north-
east one quarter of the southwest one quarter of Sec-
tion 12; thence south on said line, a distance of 475.5
feet to the north right of way line of the Chicago, Mⁱⁿ-
nesota, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad; thence north 87
degrees 57 minutes east on said north right of way line,
a distance of 800 feet; thence north 06 degrees 35 minutes
east, a distance of 129.2 feet; thence north 0 degrees
14 minutes 30 seconds west, a distance of 471.1 feet to
point of beginning containing 9.7 acres more or less.

Section 2. Copies of the petition were filed with the Town Board of
the Town of Spring Grove, Houston County, Minnesota, the County Board of the
County of Houston, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission, St. Paul, Minnesota.

Section 3. More than sixty days has expired since the filing of this
petition, and no written objections to the annexation have been received by
the City Council.

Section 4. The City Council of the City of Spring Grove has deter-
mined that it would be to the best interests of the municipality and of the
territory affected that said lands be annexed to the City of Spring Grove
and hereby does so such lands annexed to the municipality.

Section 5. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Section 616.023
Minnesota Statutes and shall become effective from and after its passage and
publication.
