ORDINANCE NO. 1769

AN ORDINANCE Annexing to the City of Rochesters Minnesofa, Certain Platted Land in Golden Hill Addition, Olmsted County, Minnesofa.

County, Minnesota.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. A pelition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Rochester, signed by a majority of the owners of land described herein, requesting the Common Council to annex said land to the City of Rochester. The land described in said pelition for annexation is located in Rochester Township, Olmsted County, Minnesota, and is described as follows:

North one-third of Lot 5, Block 21, Golden Hill Addition to Rochester, Minnesota, and the west half of 1st Avenue S.W. adjoining said lot, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County.

Said pelition has also been filed with the Town Board of Rochester Township, with the County Board of the County of Olmsted, and with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, and the Town Board of Rochester has notified the City that it has no objections to the annexation of the above-described land.

Section 2. The quantity of land included in said pelition is approximately 0.48 acres.

Section 3. The Common Council of the City of Rochester does hereby defermine that the land described in Section 1 abust upon the present territorial limits of the City of Rochester, its so conditioned as to be properly subjected to nunicipal government, and the annexation of said land will be in the best interest of the City of Rochester, Minnesota, as effectually as it it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 1. The sent that in addition to the usual assessments, it is the intention of the Common Council to assess against benefitted property all or a portion of the cost of any sform sewer, water tower and trunk line sanitary sewer construction, hereofore or hereafter undertaken to serve the area annexed by this crainance are hereby notified that in addition to the usual assessments, it is the intention of the Common Council of the City of Rochester, Minnesota with the Minnesota Municipal Commisson, the Rochester Town Clerk, the County Auditor
