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## ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND

MHEREAS, a Petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Manchester, Minnesota, signed by the owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Manchester, Minnesota:
