Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the need for a youth organization to provide for the students enrolled in office programs was recognized almost a decade ago; and*

WHEREAS: *the Office Education Association was established in 1966 as an independent youth organization for students enrolled in high school and post secondary business and office programs; and*

WHEREAS: *membership in the Office Education Association is without regard to race, creed or national origin; and*

WHEREAS: *the Minnesota Office Education Association was organized to help students develop their skills and leadership abilities through participation in vocational education, civic, recreational, and social activities;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 9 - 15, 1975 to be

and urge our citizens to commend the Office Education Association for its worthwhile purpose in uniting students enrolled in classes with office employment as their objective.
