



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the fitness of our people and the health level of all people can be assured by the availability of a balanced diet; and*

WHEREAS: *pork is a key source of many essential nutrients for Minnesota homemakers when planning family menus; and*

WHEREAS: *the Minnesota pork industry has pledged to continue to provide the citizens of the State of Minnesota with an abundant supply of wholesome and nutritious pork products; and*

WHEREAS: *we are proud of the high quality pork produced in Minnesota, which ranks fifth among the states in pork production. During 1973 cash receipts from Minnesota pork amount to \$508,645,000 and on September 1, 1974 there were 3,900,000 hogs on Minnesota farms;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 20-25, 1974 as

MINNESOTA PORK WEEK

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to remember pork products when planning their family meals
