WHEREAS: recognizing the many inestimable contributions made to the welfare of Minnesota's children and youth by professional school nurses working within the school environment; and

WHEREAS: noting that these nurses serve also the community, state and nation in providing full and varied health services; and

WHEREAS: sharing the nation's pride in their tireless leadership, service and competence;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 22, 1975 to be

MINNESOTA SCHOOL NURSE DAY

sponsored by the School Nurses Organization of Minnesota, associated with the Minnesota Education Association; and urge all citizens, all educational associations, all news media and other community organizations to join in this salute by encouraging and promoting the goals of professional school nurses as they contribute daily to the health and well-being of our nation.
