



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: the future of our state and nation lies in the hands of the youth of today, and, therefore, one of our greatest obligations is to help develop in today's young people the qualities that will enable them to make the most of that future; and

WHEREAS: qualities of temperance, respect for law, and a high sense of responsibility for the common welfare are essential qualities for the maintenance and development of healthy, happy and successful human lives and a high degree of social progress; and

WHEREAS: civic, educational, religious, social and other organizations can and do make a substantial contribution to the development of high moral, spiritual and social standards by progress of temperance education for youth;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 20 - 26, 1975 as

## YOUTH TEMPERANCE EDUCATION WEEK

in Minnesota and urge that citizens in churches, schools, clubs and as individuals, join in the observance of youth temperance education during this designated week; and further urge all Minnesotans to become alert to said education as a year around project.
