and wonder throughout the civilized world; and

WHEREAS: one of the first acts of the Congress of the United States was to establish

the patent system under which American inventors have made outstanding contributions to the world's engineering, manufacturing and scientific

projects; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota wishes to express thanks to its inventor-citizens for their contributions to the economy and welfare of this State and our Nation and to pay tribute to the United States Patent Incentive System, recalling the words of Abraham Lincoln: "The Patent System added the fuel of interest

to the fire of genius.";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 9, 1975 as

MINNESOTA INVENTORS WEEK

and February 11 as Inventors Day.
