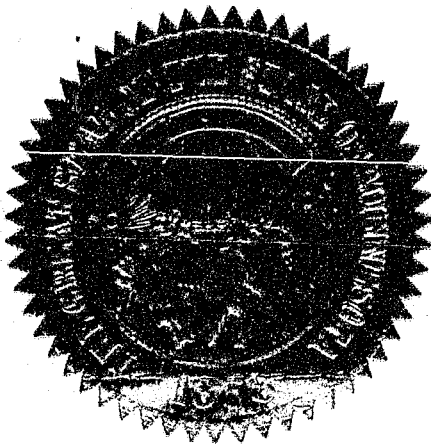
PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, One Anselm Mastila was on October 26, 1921, brutally murdered near the village of Hibbing, St. Louis County; and

WHEREAS, The peace officers of St. Louis County have been unable, after diligent effort, to apprehend the person guilty of said murder; and,

WHEREAS, Public welfare demands that the guilty person or persons be apprehended and punished according to law;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. A. O. Preus, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the State Treasury, the sum of Two Hundred the arrest and conviction, or for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons guilty of said murder.
