



# Proclamation

- WHEREAS: F. Peavey Heffelfinger has for many years given of his time and effort in promoting the cause of alcoholism prevention and control in the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: F. Peavey Heffelfinger at his own personal expense has campaigned nationwide in his efforts to bring legislation and help for the nation's No. 3 illness; and
- WHEREAS: F. Peavey Heffelfinger in his years as a successful businessman has promoted the idea that alcoholism in industry is a billion dollar headache and that the alcoholic is a sick person who needs help; and
- WHEREAS: F. Peavey Heffelfinger has served in an official advisory capacity to the State of Minnesota through its Commission on Alcohol Problems and the Citizens Advisory Council to the State Alcohol and Drug Abuse Authority; and
- WHEREAS: F. Peavey Heffelfinger has resigned from the Citizens Advisory Council because of the press of civic duties; and
- WHEREAS: F. Peavey Heffelfinger has offered to still serve the State of Minnesota in an unofficial capacity in its program for chemical dependency;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, December 27, 1974 as

F. PEAVEY HEFFELFINGER DAY

in Minnesota.
