WHEREAS: the General Assembly of the United Nations has designated 1975 as International Women's Year in recognition of the need to promote full equality of opportunity between men and women; and

WHEREAS: one of the major tasks facing society at all levels is the full integration of women into all economic, social, cultural, and political activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the year of 1975 as

INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S YEAR

in Minnesota, and do hereby commend and support all individuals and groups working toward the achievement of real equality between women and men.

FURTHERMORE, I urge all Minnesotans to recognize the need for full equality between women and men.
