



Proclamation

WHEREAS: March thirteenth will be observed by the Minnesota Music Educators Association as "Music in Our Schools Day"; and

WHEREAS: the observance is designed to bring about a more genuine recognition in Minnesota of the vital place of music in the educational process; and

WHEREAS: music is a powerful esthetic force and strengthens international understanding; and

WHEREAS: the unique qualities and content of music education dramatically express man's commitments and insights in all cultures of the world, both past and present; and help each child to communicate with others;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 13, 1975 to be

MUSIC IN OUR SCHOOLS DAY

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to continue to encourage and support this significant art.
