WHEREAS: Minnesota has risen to greatness through the quality of its competition; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has stressed physical development as necessary for the well-being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS: table tennis, along with ice hockey, represents the finest example of speed, grace and agility, involving the coordination of mind, eye and foot; and

WHEREAS: the National Table Tennis Tournament, on November 29, November 30, and December 1, brings together, for the first time in Minnesota, the finest players in the United States;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, November 30, 1974 to be

TABLE TENNIS DAY

in Minnesota.
