



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Common Cause, the citizens' lobby, has, for the past four years, been an effective voice in advocating greater openness and integrity in our Nation's government; and

WHEREAS: for the past year Common Cause in Minnesota has worked effectively for similar reforms in Minnesota, including the Ethics in Government legislation enacted by the 1974 Legislature; and

WHEREAS: John Gardner, National Chairman of Common Cause, will be in Minnesota on December 4 to help acquaint Minnesotans with the activities of Common Cause nationally and in this state; and

WHEREAS: the people of Minnesota, whether we agree or disagree with the specific legislative proposals of Common Cause, welcome the efforts of John Gardner and of Common Cause to help improve governmental openness, integrity and accountability;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 4, 1974 as

COMMON CAUSE DAY IN MINNESOTA

I further welcome John Gardner to the State of Minnesota, and urge every Minnesotan to consider his message and to become concerned and involved in every way possible with the citizen-directed effort to improve government at every level in the State of Minnesota.
