Minneapolis, Minnesota.

I do hereby recognize him as such and declare him free to exercise and enjoy such
functions, powers and privileges as are allowed to Honorary Consuls by the Law
of Nations, by the provisions of international agreements in force between
the Government of the United States and the Government of the Republic
of Korea, and by the laws of the United States.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Public, and the Seal of the
United States to be hereunto affixed.

Done at the City of Washington, this second day of September
in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty and of the
Independence of the United States of America the seventy and ninth.
