ORDINANCE NO. 1
AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE CERTAIN LOTS
AND BLOCKS OF LAND TO THE VIL-
LAGE OF DEEPHAVEN, HENNEPIN
COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Deephaven
do ordain as follows:

Section I

That all of the following described lots and
blocks of land:--

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of Lot One
(1), Section Twenty-five (25), Township 117,
North of Range 23, thence north 27 rods, thence
west to center of road running through said Lot
One (1) known as the Vine Hill Road, thence
west of south along center of said road aforesaid
to south line of said Lot One (1), thence east to
place of beginning, comprising six acres more or
less, owned entirely by Gustaf Rooth, and Hilda
C. Rooth, his wife.

And all that part of Government Lot One (1),
and the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast
Quarter of Section 25, Township 117, North of
Range 23, West of the Fifth Principal Meridian,
described as follows: Beginning at a point on
the south line of said Lot One (1) where the
same is intersected by the center line of a road
running through said Lot One (1), known as the
Vine Hill Road and Hotel St. Louis Road, thence
west along south line of said Lot One (1), and
the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter
of Section 25, 63 and 83-100 rods to a point 13 and
83-100 rods west of the Southeast Corner of the
Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter
thence north 27 rods, thence east to a point
and 5-10 feet west of center of said Vine Hill and
Hotel St. Louis Road, thence south 165 feet,
thence east to the center of the Vine Hill and
Hotel St. Louis Road, thence southerly along
center line of said road to the point of beginning,
owned entirely by Ralph L. Carlton, and Lillian
M. Carlton, his wife; and

Lots platted as Vine Hill in Township 117, Sec-
tion 25, Range 23, North Half of Lot Five (5), 2
and 1-2 acres; Lots Six (6) and (7), ten acres;
South Half of Lot Eight (8), total 15 acres, owned
by A. W. Carr, and Mary Carr, his wife.

Lot Ten (10) of Vine Hill, according to plat
thereof on record in the office of the Register of
Deeds for Hennepin County, Minn., and owned by
Joseph Timmers and Katherine Timmers, his
wife; and

Lot Nine (9) in Vine Hill Addition according to
plat thereof on file in the office of the Register of
Deeds for Hennepin County, Minnesota, owned
by W. C. Montgomery, and Mary A. Montgomery,
his wife; and

Lot Fourteen (14) of Vine Hill according to plat
thereof on record in the office of the Register of
Deeds for Hennepin County, Minnesota; and the
North Half of Lot Eight (8) according to plat
thereof now on record in the office of the Regis-
ter of Deeds in and for said Hennepin County,
Minnesota, owned by Clara E. Holcomb, and H.
S. Holcomb, her husband; and

Lot Four (4) of Vine Hill according to plat
thereof on file in the office of the Register of
Deeds for Hennepin County, Minnesota; and Lot
Eleven (11), Vine Hill, owned by Wm. F. Cowels.

South Half of Lot (5) of Vine Hill according to
plat thereof now on file in the office of the Regis-
ter of Deeds in and for said County of Hennepin,
Minnesota, owned by James Grathwol, and
Katherine G. Grathwol.

The West 110 Feet of Lots Two (2) and Three
(3) according to plat thereof now on file in the
office of Register of Deeds, County of Hennepin,
Minnesota, owned by M. C. Williams.

Lots Two (2) and Three (3) in Vine Hill except
the west 110 Feet of said Lots Two (2) and Three
(3), according to plat thereof now on file and of
record in office of the Register of Deeds for Coun-
ty of Hennepin, Minnesota, owned by J. G.
Bjornstad; and

One and One-Half Acres, commencing in center
of Vine Hill Road 445 and 5-10 feet north of south
line of Government Lot One (1), thence west 4
and 5-10 feet, thence south 165 feet, thence east
to center of road, thence northeasterly to point
of beginning, Section 25, Township 117, Range
23, owned by Mrs. Ep. Leland;

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A CERTAIN
PORTION OR PART OF DEPOT STREET
IN THE VILLAGE OF DEEPHAVEN,
HENNEPIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Deephaven
do ordain as follows:

Section I

That all of that part of Depot Street lying be-
tween Lots one (1), two (2) and three (3) of Bay
St. Louis, and the right of way of the Minneapo-
lis and St. Paul Suburban Railway Company,
comprising a plot of ground forty
feet square, lying north of the south line of Lot
Three (3) in said original plat of Bay St. Louis,
according to plat thereof of record and now on
file in the office of the Register of Deeds for
Hennepin County, Minnesota, be, and the same
is hereby declared vacated.

Section I
