

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WARREN SPANNAUS, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and upon the written request of the Department of Administration (a copy of which is attached), do hereby constitute and appoint

BOYD H. RATCHYE and DOHERTY, RUMBLE & BUTLER


of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Attorneys to represent the State of Minnesota in pending negotiations and arbitration proceedings relating to construction of the Centennial parking ramp facility and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General. This appointment shall be effective on November 19, 1974, and is subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth:

1. REPORTS. The Special Attorneys shall submit a monthly report to the Attorney General setting forth in detail their activities regarding this appointment; as to all matters in litigation, they shall submit a monthly report on forms provided by the Attorney General.

2. COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. As compensation for satisfactory performance of the duties herein described, the Special Attorneys shall be compensated at the rate of Forty-five Dollars (\$45.00) per hour. The Special Attorneys shall be reimbursed for disbursements and for travel expenses in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by the State of Minnesota, Commissioner of Administration governing the travel of state officers and employees. All compensation and expenses shall be paid from funds appropriated to the Department of Administration.


3. STATUS. The Special Attorneys shall not be considered state employees, shall not be eligible for the state's life insurance or basic health benefits coverage and shall not accrue vacation or sick leave or any benefits other than those expressly provided herein.




