KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WARREN SPANNAUS, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and upon the request of the State of Minnesota, Department of Personnel (copy attached), do hereby constitute and appoint

BRIGGS AND MORGAN


of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Attorneys for the purpose of representing the State with respect to district court review of the Public Employees Relations Board decision on the Red Wing Training School Bargaining Unit, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General. This appointment shall be effective September 12, 1973, and is subject to the terms and conditions set forth below. Said appointment shall terminate July 31, 1974.

1. REPORTS. The Special Attorneys shall submit a monthly report setting forth in detail their activities regarding this appointment.

2. COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. As compensation for satisfactory performance of the duties herein described, the Special Attorneys shall be compensated on a \$50.00 per hour basis. The Special Attorneys shall be reimbursed for travel expenses in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by the State of Minnesota, Commissioner of Administration governing the travel of state employees and officers. All compensation and expenses shall be paid from funds appropriated to the Department of Personnel.

3. STATUS. The Special Attorneys shall not be considered state employees, shall not be eligible for the state's life insurance or basic health benefits coverage, and shall not accrue vacation or sick leave or any benefits other than those expressly provided herein.




Dear Attorney General Spannaus:


