A RESOLUTION ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS OWNED BY THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO THE CITY OF BRECKENRIDGE, WILKIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Chapter No. 104 of the Second Regular Session of the 68th Legislature of the State of Minnesota, a law duly enacted and approved by the governing body of the City of Breckenridge in accordance with the provisions of Section 645.021 of the Minnesota Statutes, the City of Breckenridge was authorized to annex by resolution certain lands owned by the State of Minnesota currently being used by the State of Minnesota for highway right of way, which sand land is located in the County of Wilkin, State of Minnesota, and is described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference thereto.

AND WHEREAS, The State of Minnesota has duly petitioned the City of Breckenridge, Minnesota, to annex said lands more fully described in Exhibit "A" referred to hereinabove.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Breckenridge, Minnesota:

- 1. That it is hereby found and determined that said petition is in proper form and has been duly executed by the State of Minnesota in accordance with the laws in such case made and provided.
- 2. That it is hereby found and determined that the State of Minnesota is the owner of said property described more fully in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and that said lands are unplatted and do not exceed 200 acres in area.
- 3. That it is hereby found and determined that the property to be annexed is being used for highway right of way purposes and that said property is now urban or suburban in character.
- 4. That it is hereby found and determined that the annexation of the said lands is in the best interests of the State of Minnesota and the City of Breckenridge.
- 5. That it is hereby found and determined that no persons presently reside upon said lands proposed to be annexed and that said lands abut upon the city boundary at the North line thereof.
- 6. That it is hereby found and determined that all of the requirements of said legislative act, Chapter 104 of the Second Regular Session of the 68th Legislature of the State of Minnesota, have now been fulfilled and that it is therefore feasible and practical that this land be annexed.
- 7. That it is hereby found and determined that none of said property proposed to be annexed is presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough.
- 8. That the corporate limits of the City of Breckenridge, Minnesota, be and they hereby are extended to include the land more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference thereto, and that the said land is hereby annexed to and included within the City of Breckenridge, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.
- 9. That the City Clerk be and he hereby is directed to mail a certified copy of this resolution to the Minnesota Municipal Commission, to the Secretary of the State of Minnesota, to the County Auditor of Wilkin County, Minnesota, to the Clerk of the Township of Breckenridge, Minnesota, and to the Attorney General of the State of Minnesota.
