An unsurveyed Island located in the central portion of the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 17, Township 63 North, Range 13 West, 4th P.M., lying South 87 degrees West 50 Chains from the North M.C. of Lot 6 of said Section, and One (1) Chain from the East shore-line of Lot 1 of Sec. 17-63-13, containing approximately 0.80 acre.

An unsurveyed Island located in the central portion of $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 17, Township 63 North, Range 13 West, 4th P.M., lying South 80 degrees West 28 Chains from the North M.C. of Lot 6 of said Section, and 5 chains north of the north point of Lot 7 of Sec. 17-63-13, containing approximately 0.30 acre.

An unsurveyed Island located in the central portion of the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 17, Township 63 North, Range 13 West, 4th P.M., lying South 72 degrees West 37 Chains from the North M.C. of Lot 6 of said Section, and North 45° West 4 chains from the west point of Lot 7 of Sec. 17-63-13, containing approximately 0.25 acre.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said Islands should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
