## EXECUTIVE ORDER 90

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, 1973 Supplement, Section 43,321 directs the Commissioner of Personnel to promulgate by Personnel Rule procedures relating to grievances of any state officer or employee in the executive branch and provide the circumstances under which the grievance procedure is available, except that no state employee may avail himself of more than one grievance procedure on any one complaint, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Personnel has promulgated Personnel Rules including procedures for the resolution of disputes and complaints arising between employees of the State of Minnesota and their supervisors and/or appointing authorities, and

WHEREAS, such rules have been approved by the Office of the Attorney General, filed with the Secretary of State and become effective, and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Executive Order #66 establishing a grievance procedure for use by state employees, not covered by grievance procedures authorized by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act have been superseded by Personnel Rules 176-178.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order that the provisions of Executive Order #66, issued on August 21, 1973, be rescinded.
