Jan Garleon Shows Secretary of State

WHEREAS, the governor of the State of Minnesota is empowered to receive and administer certain federal funds pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 4.07 (1974), and

WHEREAS, said governor is empowered to delegate to and direct the Department of Administration and its Commissioner to administer federal funds pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 4.07 and 16.028 (1974), and

WHEREAS, certain Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA), Public Service Employment (PSE) monies are to be administered by the governor.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do, by this Order, delegate to the Commissioner of Administration of the State of Minnesota and his delegates the administering CETA, PSE monies. Specifically, said Commissioner and his delegates shall:

- 1. Enter into contracts with prime sponsors for CETA, PSE funds,
- 2. Enter into contracts with state agencies ultimately receiving CETA, PSE funds, and
- 3. Undertake responsibility for necessary reporting to prime sponsors and abide by all federal regulations regarding CETA, PSE funds.

The Commissioner and his delegates shall execute all contracts in accordance with a plan developed by the Office of the Governor.

This Delegation Order shall be effective January 30, 1975.
