- AS: the National Audubon Society and the Minneapolis Chapter will observe the month of April as a period to recruit citizens concerned with the conservation of our natural environment; and
- AS: John James Audubon, the French-born American naturalist and painter, created with his skillful hands the inspiration which has led devoted friends of America's wildlife to work for the preservation of our precious animals of the field and forest for more than a century; and
- AS: it is fitting that all Minnesotans who treasure the natural resources of this state and nation and the animals of this environment join with the Audubon Society in assisting in this vital conservation movement;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby

name the month of April, 1975, as

AUDUBON MONTH

Minnesota, and urge all citizens to lend their hearts and help to this worthwhile work.
