



Proclamation

- AS: the State of Minnesota is noted for providing a standard of living which encompasses both the dignity and the realization of accomplishment which all people seek; and
- AS: the State of Minnesota is continually increasing its efforts on behalf of the mentally handicapped of this state so that they too may achieve their deserved dignity and accomplishments; and
- AS: the people of the State of Minnesota realize that the rationality and morality of specialized instruction and care benefit everyone; and
- AS: private programs around the state work with and for state-funded organizations in attempts to aid the mentally handicapped; and
- AS: Minnesota Honey Sunday, sponsored by the Minnesota Jaycees, will raise funds for programs and facilities for the mentally handicapped throughout the state;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 14 - 20, 1975 as

HONEY SUNDAY WEEK

Minnesota, and urge the good people of Minnesota to support this and other programs in their state and their communities to aid the mentally handicapped.
