MCW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 12, 1975 as

REHABILITATION DAY

in Minnesota, and wrge that the citizens give full support to the continuation and growth of programs which facilitate the rehabilitation of handicapped individuals, to the benefit both of those individuals and the society scenerally.
