WHEREAS: thousands of citizens of this state are active members of the Minnesota Army and Air National Guard; and

WHEREAS: these citizen-soldiers, both locally and nationally, have demonstrated their dedication to the defense of the nation and have been called to duty countless times during their more than 200 year history; and

WHEREAS: they have been deeply committed over the past years to work in support of their communities, to protect lives and property in case of local emergency, and to defend our freedom in time of national emergency or war; and

WHEREAS: they now stand ready to serve their state and country in the true spirit of the Minuteman of Colonial and Revolutionary days;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim in honor of the National Guard, the month of March 1975 to be

MINUTEMAN MONTH

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and of the State, the one hundred and seventeenth.
