Proclamation

WHEREAS: Ove M. Wangensteen, a native of St. Paul, Minnesota, is an outstanding product of its schools including Mattocks Grade School, St. Paul Luther High School and Macalester College, from which he received a B.A. in 1939; and

WHEREAS: Ove Wangensteen began his illustrious career in the field of public welfare a quarter of a century ago as a social worker with the Meeker County Welfare Board; and

WHEREAS: his career further spanned periods of employment in various executive capacities with the Meeker County Welfare Board and the St. Louis County Welfare Board; and

WHEREAS: Ove Wangensteen has served varying periods as Assistant Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner and Acting Commissioner with the Minnesota Department of Public Welfare; and

WHEREAS: Ove Wangensteen has consistently demonstrated compassion for the needs of all citizens, respect for their dignity as human beings, and an awareness and understanding of the changing and enlightened philosophy guiding the policies of the agencies he has served so faithfully; and

WHEREAS: for so many years, his wise administrative talents and capacity for leadership have served to strengthen and advance the Minnesota Department of Public Welfare;
