



Proclamation

WHEREAS: John W. (Jack) Hoffmann, is retiring this month after 42 years of service with the Northern States Power Company; and

WHEREAS: Jack Hoffmann, in more than four decades of employment at NSP, has worked throughout the company service area in a variety of positions; and

WHEREAS: Jack Hoffmann, since 1962, as a company officer, has represented NSP at the Minnesota Legislature and has earned the reputation as an effective and respected spokesman for his company; and

WHEREAS: as senior vice president of NSP, Jack Hoffmann has been a significant force in the company's enlightened and successful effort to involve the public in the siting of generating and transmission facilities; and

WHEREAS: such action contributed substantially to the passage of the Minnesota Power Plant Siting Act of 1973;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, March 12, 1975 to be

in Minnesota.
