ORDINANCE NO. 254

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE
CITY OF REDWOOD FALLS

THE CITY OF REDWOOD FALLS DOES ORDAIN:

1. That it is hereby found and determined:

(A) That the lands hereinafter described abut on the City of Redwood Falls; that said lands are less than two hundred acres in area and are unplatted; and that a Petition for Annexation of said lands to the City of Redwood Falls is on file in the office of the Redwood Falls City Clerk and has been signed by the owner of said lands.

(B) That said lands are urban in character.

(C) That said lands are suitably conditioned for municipal government.

(D) That it is for the best interests of the City of Redwood Falls and the owner and residents of said lands that the same be annexed to the City of Redwood Falls.

2. That the following described lands lying and being in the County of Redwood and State of Minnesota are hereby annexed to the City of Redwood Falls:

All that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twelve (12), Township One Hundred Twelve (112) North, Range Thirty-six (36) West described as follows:

Commencing at the center line of U. S. Highway No. 71 at a point 124 feet South of the intersection of said center line and the North line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 12, Township 112 N, Range 36 W, and running thence West parallel with the North line of said Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 12 a distance of 300 feet, thence North a distance of 124 feet to the North line of said Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 12, thence West along said North line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 12 a distance of 105 feet, thence South a distance of 134 feet, thence East parallel with the said North line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) a distance of 405 feet more or less to the center line of U. S. Highway No. 71, thence North along the center line of said U. S. Highway No. 71 to the point of beginning.
