You will please take notice, that the undersigned, will, within 30 days, file an application in the General Land Office, at Washington, D.C., for the survey of those Three (3) unsurveyed Islands located in East Coxeys Pond, St. Louis County, Minnesota, more particularly described as follows:

An unsurveyed Island located in the Southwest portion of NE¹ of NE¹, Section 29, Township 64 North, Range 13 West, 4th P.M., lying South 45 degrees West 17 Chains from the N.E. corner of said Section; 4 chains South from N.W. point of Lot 1, and 5 chains East from N.E. shore line of Lot 2 of Sec. 29-64-13, containing approximately 1.40 acres.

An unsurveyed Island located in the Northern portion of the SW¹ of NE¹, Section 29, Township 64 North, Range 13 West, 4th P.M., lying South 42 degrees West 40 Chains from the N.E. Corner of said Section, and 4 Chains East from Northeast shore line of Lot 5 of Sec. 29-64-13, containing approximately 0.20 acre.

An unsurveyed Island located in the central portion of the NW¹ of SE¹, Section 29, Township 64 North, Range 13 West, 4th P.M., lying South 32 degrees West about 55 Chains from the N.E. corner of said Section, and 3 chains West from the N.W. shore-line of Lot 7 of Sec. 29-64-13, containing approximately 0.20 acre.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said Islands should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
