



Proclamation

- REAS: the Reserve Officers' Training Corps, ROTC, is the primary source of commissioned officers for the military; and
- REAS: the Air Force ROTC program at the College of St. Thomas has continually provided the Air Force with officers since its initiation in June of 1948; and
- REAS: the efficiency and vitality of the Air Force depends to a great extent upon the calibre of its young officers, many of whom are obtained each year through the ROTC programs; and
- REAS: the unit will be culminating its activities of the year with a Drill Competition, an Awards Presentation, a Dining-Out and a Military Ball on May 3, 1975;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, May 3, 1975 as
