



Proclamation

the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries will hold its Twelfth Annual Convention in the City of St. Paul on April 24 and 25, 1975; and

all of the members of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries solemnly bind themselves under their Code of Ethics to maintain the highest standards in their contacts with Government, Courts, law offices, clients, and any and all persons; and

the efficiency of the professional services of legal secretaries is of first importance to Government, the Courts, and to attorneys and their clients; and

one of the aims and purposes of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries is to further the education of its members and to increase their knowledge of the law; and

it is in the public interest that legal secretaries have the opportunity to observe the Government with which they are so closely associated by reason of their profession as legal secretaries; and

the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches of the State of Minnesota are cooperating with the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries in presenting an educational program that will be of benefit to the legal secretaries in attendance from throughout the State;

WHEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 25, 1975 as

LEGAL SECRETARIES DAY

...ta, and urge all citizens to recognize and appreciate the safeguards to our liberty by our government of laws and by the orderly process of our courts.
