



Proclamation

REAS: we have been endowed by our Creator not only with the blessings and benefits of our animal friends, who provide us clothing, food and pleasure in life, but also with a responsibility to protect them, and to show them kindness; and

REAS: the people in the State of Minnesota are deeply indebted to the Minnesota Humane Society for the contribution they make each year in educating our children in humane principles, and in promoting a true working spirit of kindness and consideration for animals in the minds and hearts of all our people; and

REAS: we recognize the timeless value of the teaching of kindness to our young people through humane education, and realize that out of kindness to animals grows kindness and love for both Man and God; and

REAS: the first full week of May has been set as the annual celebration of the national week observing the philosophy of kindness to animals;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do claim the week of May 4 - 10, 1975 as

BE KIND TO ANIMALS WEEK

Minnesota, and urge all citizens to participate in the events relating to this
