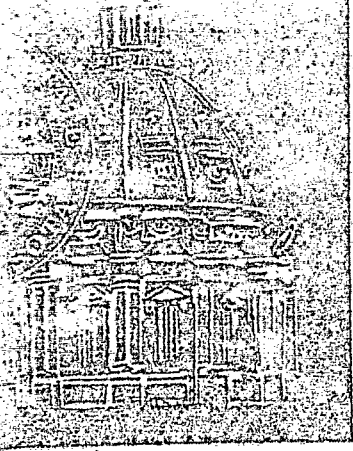




Proclamation

EAS: this is the centennial year of America's Agricultural Experiment Stations, and the ninetieth year of the University of Minnesota's Agricultural Experiment Station; and

EAS: Minnesota's Agricultural Experiment Station has contributed immeasurably to Minnesota's economy and to the wealth and well being of its citizens; and

EAS: those who support and conduct agricultural research in Minnesota have served the food and agriculture industry and the entire citizenry with a high degree of responsiveness, dedication, and distinction; and

EAS: the importance of agricultural research is growing daily in light of impending world food shortages; and

EAS: there are problems facing American families that can only be solved through research;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do by declare Friday, April 25, 1975 as

AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION DAY

Minnesota, and urge all citizens of the state to reflect on the importance of agricultural research on this day.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and of the State, the one hundred and seventeenth.
