WHEREAS: there are more than 80,000 players participating in organized hockey programs throughout the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: there are more than 2,000 registered hockey teams in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: the playing of hockey serves to build strong, healthy bodies; develop keen, alert minds, promoting good sportsmanship and camaraderie among young people; and

WHEREAS: a Minnesota team has won the National Bantam Hockey Championship for each of the past five years; and

WHEREAS: District II, the northern Ramsey County suburban area is hosting the National Bantam Hockey Tournament on April 4, 5 and 6;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April as
