



Proclamation

WHEREAS: private real property ownership is an inherent right of all, and the mainstay of free society, evidenced in Minnesota and throughout the nation by the many millions of Americans who live in their own homes; and

WHEREAS: this right has been vigorously upheld by the Realtors of Minnesota who have consistently sought to upgrade the professionalism of the industry, by voluntary subscription to a rigid code of ethics and educational programs; and

WHEREAS: the citizens of our state have benefited in countless ways from the efforts of Realtors in civic affairs, for charitable causes, and, most important, in the donation of their professional knowledge of real estate matters for the good of our communities and our state; and

WHEREAS: realtors have assumed this responsibility, by encouraging wise use of the land by advocating programs fostering home ownership, by solving problems in our cities, towns, and our environment through the activities of their broad Make America Better Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 20 - 26, 1975 to be

in Minnesota, and urge my fellow citizens to join with the Minnesota Association of Realtors and the more than 500,000 realtors and realtor associates across this nation in its observance.
