



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the residents and visitors of the State of Minnesota enjoy clean and beautiful surroundings; and

WHEREAS: each generation must work to sustain the environment, otherwise, through carelessness and indifference, its beauty and cleanliness may be lost; and

WHEREAS: special efforts must be directed against litter pollution;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell Anderson, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 9, 1975 as

CLEAN UP MINNESOTA DAY

in Minnesota, and urge all our citizens to take extra effort on that day to beautify their surroundings by removing unsightly litter and to pay special attention to the advantages of a clean Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventeenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and of the State, the one hundred and seventeenth.
