- EAS: our state has developed a large overseas market for agricultural and manufactured products; and
- EAS: tens of thousands of Minnesotans travel abroad on business and pleasure each year; and
- EAS: we receive thousands of foreign students and visitors each year; and
- EAS: we are part of the American nation in an interdependent world requiring collaboration with other nations in solving fundamental issues of resources, the environment, economics, war and peace; and
- EAS: this enormous commitment to a life of peace and well being on this small planet demands better education about world affairs for all our citizens;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby

call the month of May, 1975 to be

WORLD AFFAIRS MONTH

in Minnesota, and urge teachers and community leaders to devote more of their time and energy to the education of Minnesotans about world affairs.
