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AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, MINNE-SOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS.

The Village Council of the Village of Brewster Do Ordains

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Village Council of the Village of Brewster, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the Village of Brewster, Minnesota:

Part of the SWA of the SEA of Section 24, Township 103 North, Range 39 West, Nobles County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the SWA of the SWA of said Section 2h, thence North 89 degrees - 37.5 minutes East along the Scuth line of the SWA of the SEA of said Section 2h, 200.0 feet; thence North 10 degrees -07.5 minutes East, 520.8 feet to the Southerly right of way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway; thence South 48 degrees - 03 minutes West along the said right of way line 392.0 feet to the West line of the SWA of the SEA of said Section 2h; thence due South along the West line of the SWA of the SEA of said Section 2h; thence due South along the West line of the SWA of the SEA of said Section 2h, 252.2 feet to the point of beginning and being subject to the existing easement to the public for highway right of way over and across the Southeast corner of the above described tract.

Beginning at the South Quarter corner of said Section 24; thence South 89 degrees - 38 minutes West along the South line of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 24, 282.6 feet to the Southeasterly right of way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway; thence North 48 degrees - 03 minutes East along the said right of way line 380.0 feet to the East line of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 24; thence due South along the East line of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 24, 252.2 feet to the place of beginning and containing 0.82 acres of land, more or less,

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is J acres.

Section 3. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Brewster, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government. Section h. The corporate limits of the Village are kereby exampled to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file cortified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of Hersey Township, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 5.
