

RESOLUTION

No. 11-208-74

At a regular meeting of the City Council held November 26, 1974, Alderman Narverud, seconded by Alderman Worth introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

ORDINANCE NO. 399

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN CITY OWNED  
REAL ESTATE TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS.

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following described real estate situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, abutting the city limits of the City of Thief River Falls, the fee simple title to which is in the City of Thief River Falls, to-wit:

A parcel of land which is part of the E1/2 of the SE1/4, Section 32, T. 154 N., R. 43 W. Bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East line of said Section 32 which point lies 1,240 feet South of the intersection of the South line of First Street and the Said East line of Section 32; thence in a westerly direction along a line parallel to the said South line of First Street a distance of 845 feet; thence in a southerly direction along a line parallel to the East line of said Section 32 a distance of 2,078.7 feet to the South line of said Section 32; thence in an Easterly direction along the said South line of Section 32 a distance of 845.16 feet to the Southeast corner of said Section 32; thence in a Northerly direction along the East line of said Section 32 a distance of 2,057 feet to the point of beginning; containing 40.1 acres more or less,

is hereby declared annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
