## Ordinance No. 198

### AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HERON LAKE, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Heron Lake Do Ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Heron Lake, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Heron Lake, Minnesota:

A tract of land in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section Twenty 20), Township One Hundred Four (104), Range Thirty-seven (37), Jackson County, Minnesota, described as follows: Starting at the Northeast corner of Hanson's Second Addition to the Village (Now City) of Heron Lake as the point of beginning; thence North 937 feet; thence West 335 feet to the West line of said Section 20; thence South on the West line of said Section 20 a distance of 937 feet; thence East on the North line of Hanson's Second Addition to the Village (Now City) of Heron Lake to the point of beginning; subject to an easement to Jackson County as to the West 35 feet of the above described tract for the highway purposes.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described is 7.20 Acres.

Section 3. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the City of Heron Lake, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section 4. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. The City Clerk is

hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of Wiemer Township, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copy as directed in Section 5.
