WHEREAS: the Salvation Army has rendered devoted service to God and man for over 100 years, and has ministered to the spiritual and material needs of the people of Minnesota since 1869; and

WHEREAS: the Salvation army, since its founding, has considered all men to be children of God who recognizes no distinction of color, creed, or national origin among His sons; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, May 15, 1975 as

SALVATION ARMY DAY

in Minnesota and do urge all citizens to join me in honoring the dedicated and compassionate service of the Salvation Army and its representatives in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fourth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and of the State, the one hundred and seventeenth.
