Upon the request of the Honorable R. B. Safford, or by any member of the firm of Shaw, Safford, Ray and Shaw, but all under his direction, but whether done by Mr. Safford personally, or by some other member of his firm, in no event shall the compensation paid exceed twenty dollars (\$20.00) for all work done on any particular day.
