WHEREAS: Hadassah, the Women's Zionist Organization of America and its dedicated membership of over 335,000 women is an outstanding example of American Voluntarism; and

WHEREAS: Hadassah has made an historic contribution to the forging of the bands of friendship between the people of the United States and the people of Israel; and

WHEREAS: Hadassah is about to reopen its famed Hadassah Mount Scopus Hospital in Jerusalem for the good of all the people;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby express the pride of the residents of this great State in the noble humanitarian work of Hadassah, an organization which has had the courage, determination and greatness of heart to rebuild this great medical facility after it was evacuated in 1948 during Israel's War of Independence.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and of the State, the one hundred and seventeenth.
