WHEREAS: more than 200,000 babies in the United States are born each year with crippling birth defects; and

WHEREAS: the proper care of our children should be a main goal of this community; and

WHEREAS: prompt and skilled prenatal care can help ease the burden of birth defects; and

WHEREAS: it is through the support of the scientific research and health educational programs sponsored by The National Foundation-March of Dimes, that we do our part in this task;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 11 - 17, 1975 as

HEALTHY BABY WEEK

in Minnesota, and encourage all citizens who are concerned about future generations to support programs of prenatal health care in our community.
