WHEREAS: one of the hallmarks of a truly civilized nation is the efforts it makes on behalf of its handicapped citizens; and

WHEREAS: communication is the cohesive force in every human culture and a dominant influence in the personal life of every one of us; and

WHEREAS: corrective services are available to an estimated three hundred and sixty thousand Minnesotans and twenty-two million Americans who suffer from some form of hearing or speech disability; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the month of May

HEARING AND SPEECH MONTH

in Minnesota, and commend the humanitarian and rehabilitative services, both public and private, available to citizens with hearing and speech disorders.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and of the State, the one hundred and seventeenth.
