WHEREAS: Reverend S. G. Norris has served the congregation of Apostolic Bible Church (formerly Midway Tabernacle) in Saint Paul for over 41 years as pastor and pastor emeritus; and

WHEREAS: he founded the Apostolic Bible Institute of Saint Paul in 1937 and has served continuously as its president to the present; and

WHEREAS: the Apostolic Bible Institute has trained thousands of Christian workers, pastors and missionaries who came to Saint Paul from every state and many foreign countries, and hundreds of them are now serving throughout the United States and the world in positions of Christian leadership and humanitarian concern; and
