



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the type of emergency pre-hospital care for the critically injured in Minnesota is dependent upon the training available to those emergency medical technicians who provide this service; and

WHEREAS: advanced life-saving procedures administered at the accident scene have added new and additional responsibilities to the Emergency Medical Technicians; and

WHEREAS: the Congress of the United States through the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare has recognized this need for emergency care and has provided funds to the Minnesota Vocational Division of Education to implement a much needed Statewide Emergency Medical Technician Training Program; and

WHEREAS: the Statewide Emergency Medical Technician Advisory Task Force, by representative assembly, has established the last week in May as "Minnesota Emergency Medical Technician Week" and is supported by the Minnesota Vocational Division and the Minnesota State Department of Health in this action;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 26 - June 1, 1975 as

MINNESOTA EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens of the State to observe this week by becoming aware of the emergency care given in their local area either by the police, fire, rescue or ambulance personnel and by supporting the need for the trained Emergency Medical Technicians.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and of the State, the one hundred and seventeenth.
